PGY-1 BLOCK SCHEDULE:

- Our academic year is divided into 13 blocks instead of 12 months.
- Each block represents a 4-week rotation.
 - **SITE 1:** Memorial Hospital West (MHW)
 - **SITE 2:** Memorial Regional Hospital (MRH)
 - **SITE 3:** Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital (JDCH)
- **ROTATION:**
 - **ORIENT/EM:** Orientation and Emergency Medicine. The first block of the PGY I year is designed to provide incoming residents with the tools necessary for a successful transition from medical student to EM resident. This 4-week dedicated block includes one week of clinical shifts in the EDs of all three sites.
 - **EM/US:** Emergency Medicine and Ultrasound. This includes 2 weeks of Emergency Medicine shifts and 2 weeks of focused Emergency Medicine Ultrasound training, all conducted in the ED at our SITE 1
 - **PEM:** Pediatric Emergency Medicine. This 4-week block focuses on pediatric emergency care exclusively at our own children's hospital, Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital (JDCH). (In the first year, our residents do two dedicated four-week blocks of PEM at SITE #3.)
 - **ANES/V:** Anesthesia and Vacation. Consists of 3 weeks of anesthesia training, complemented by 1 week of vacation. This rotation takes place at MHM our SITE #1
 - **EMS/V:** Emergency Medical Services and Vacation. Consists of 3 weeks of EMS, complemented by one week of vacation. This is centered at SITE #1.
- **TOTAL EM PGY I:** This is calculated as all EM weeks minus vacation weeks, which is 31 in the first year. Please note that all US education takes place in the ED.
- **TOTAL PEM PGY I:** Indicates the total number of weeks dedicated to Pediatric Emergency Medicine weeks. For PGY-1, this is 8 weeks.

PGY-2 BLOCK SCHEDULE:

This section outlines the rotation schedule for second-year residents (PGY-2).

- **SITE 1:** Memorial Hospital West (MHW)
- **SITE 2:** Memorial Regional Hospital (MRH)
- **SITE 3:** Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital (JDCH)

- **ROTATION:**
 - **EM:** In our second year of training, residents enjoy both adult emergency medicine and the longitudinal pediatric emergency medicine experience at our two dedicated Pediatric Emergency Departments. Emergency Medicine at SITE #1 Memorial Hospital West has 4 weeks of training with 1 week of Pediatric experience. We are grateful to the RRC for clarifying the calculation of the longitudinal pediatric experience in the recent FAQ update 05/2024. As such, we have labeled the assigned fraction of each ED on our block diagram as to **FRACTION EM** row in order to facilitate the calculation of the pediatric experience. For example, PGY 2 year **Block #1** has 4 total EM weeks with 1 PEM week. This PEM fraction is 1 week. (reminder that SITE #1 is MHW with a separate dedicated Pediatric ED)
 - **SICU:** Surgical Intensive Care Unit.
 - **EM/US:** Emergency Medicine and Ultrasound. This includes two weeks of Emergency Medicine shifts and two weeks of focused ultrasound training taking place in the ED. In our second year residents on EM/US are generally scheduled for a minimum of 16 shifts per month. During the two weeks of EM this accounts for 8 shifts in ED. Of the 8 clinical EM shifts, 2 are pediatric EM shifts at our dedicated pediatric emergency department on SITE #1. We have assigned 0.25 weeks to these two shifts in the FRACTION EM row.
 - **EM/V:** Emergency Medicine and Vacation. It includes two weeks of Emergency Medicine shifts and two weeks of vacation. Similar to EM/US, in our second year, residents are generally scheduled for a minimum of 16 shifts per month. During the two weeks of EM, this number is 8 shifts. Of the 8 clinical EM shifts, two are pediatric EM shifts at our dedicated pediatric emergency department. We have labeled these two shifts in the FRACTION EM row and assigned 0.25 weeks as the Pediatric EM fraction.

- **PICU:** Pediatric Intensive Care Unit.
- **TOTAL EM PGY II:** Indicates the total number of weeks dedicated to Emergency Medicine rotations for PGY-2, which is 36 weeks.
- **TOTAL PEM FRACTION PGY II:** Indicates the total number of weeks dedicated to Pediatric Emergency Medicine rotations for PGY-2, which is 7.75 weeks.

PGY-3 BLOCK SCHEDULE:

This section outlines the rotation schedule for third-year residents (PGY-3).

- **SITE 1:** Memorial Hospital West (MHW)
- **SITE 2:** Memorial Regional Hospital (MRH)
- **SITE 3:** Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital (JDCH)
- **SITE 4:** Memorial Hospital Miramar (MHM) (ONLY seniors currently rotate at MHM)
- **ROTATION:**
 - **EM/ELECT:** The rotation is evenly split between two weeks of Emergency Medicine and two weeks of Elective time. Residents are scheduled for 16 shifts per month. During the two weeks of EM, they are scheduled for 8 shifts in the Emergency Department. Of the 8 clinical EM shifts, two are pediatric EM shifts at our dedicated pediatric emergency department. We have labeled these two shifts in the FRACTION EM row and assigned them 0.25 weeks.
 - **EM/OB:** The rotation is evenly split between two weeks of Emergency Medicine and two weeks of OB time. Residents are scheduled for 16 shifts per month. During the two weeks of EM, they are scheduled for 8 shifts in the Emergency Department. Of the 8 clinical EM shifts, two are pediatric EM shifts at our dedicated pediatric emergency department. We have assigned 0.25 weeks as PEM fraction.

- **EM/V:** Emergency Medicine and Vacation. Includes 2 weeks of Emergency Medicine shifts and 2 weeks of vacation. Residents are scheduled for 16 shifts per month. During the two weeks of EM, this number is 8 shifts in EM. Of the 8 clinical EM shifts, two are pediatric EM shifts at our dedicated pediatric emergency department. We have assigned 0.25 weeks as PEM fraction.
- **EM/ADMIN:** Emergency Medicine and Administration. Combines two weeks of EM shifts with two weeks of learning about EM administration fundamentals. The PEM fraction is calculated as all the above-split rotations. During the two weeks of EM, they are scheduled for eight shifts in the Emergency Department. Of the eight clinical EM shifts, two are pediatric EM shifts at our dedicated pediatric emergency department. We have assigned 0.25 weeks as PEM fraction. The EM part of the EM/ADMIN rotation takes place for two weeks at SITE #2 for adult EM and SITE #3 for PEM at JoeDimaggio Children's Hospital. The Administrative part is located at Memorial Hospital West our SITE #1. (The residents never travel between 2 sites on any given day.)
- **TOTAL EM PGY III:** Indicates the total number of weeks dedicated to Emergency Medicine rotations for PGY-3, which is 38 weeks.
- **TOTAL PEM PGY III:** Indicates the total number of weeks dedicated to Pediatric Emergency Medicine rotations for PGY-3, which is 8.25 weeks.

TOTAL EM TIME = 105/156 WEEKS = 67.30%
